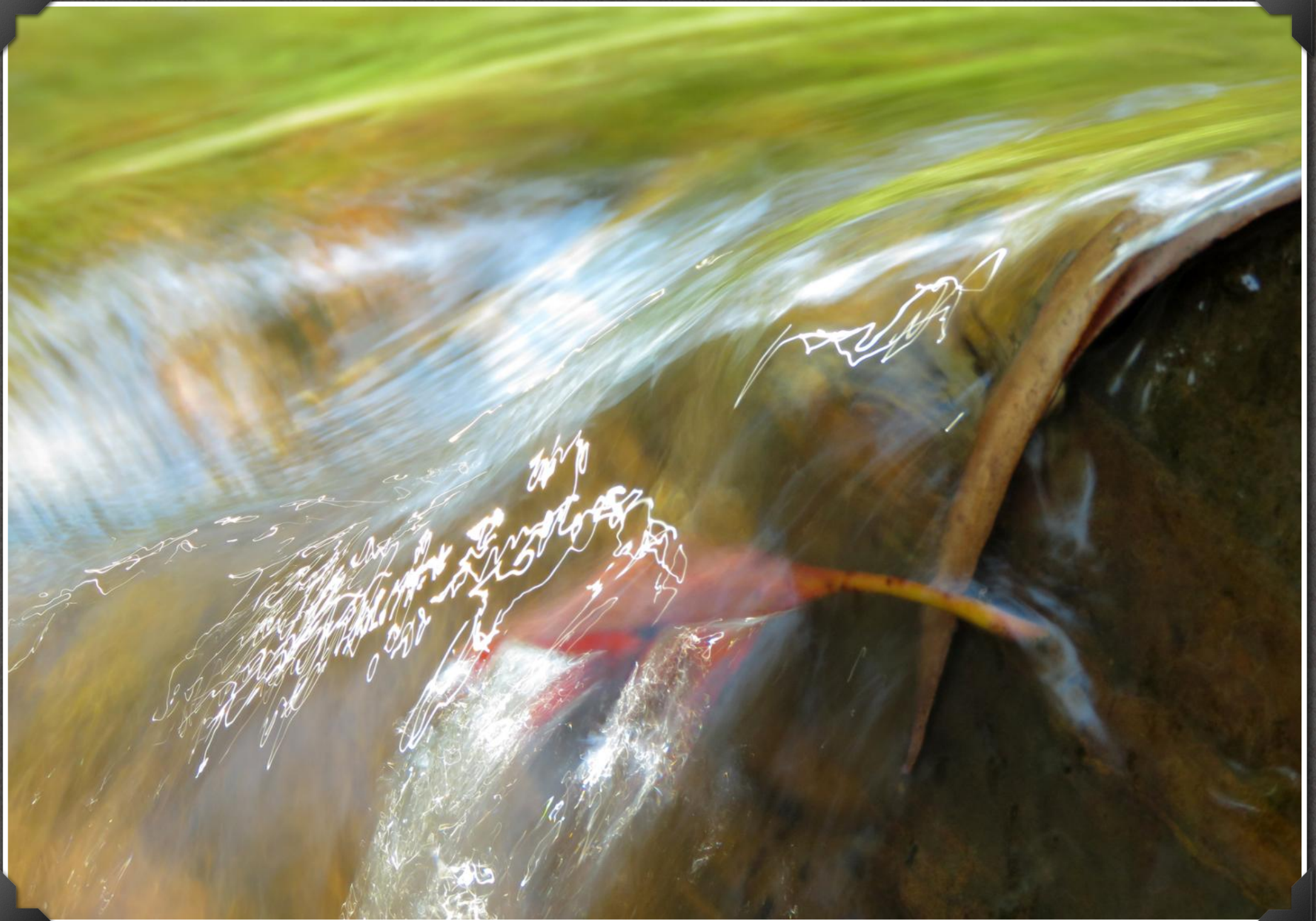

A line that curls and loops in an irregular pattern











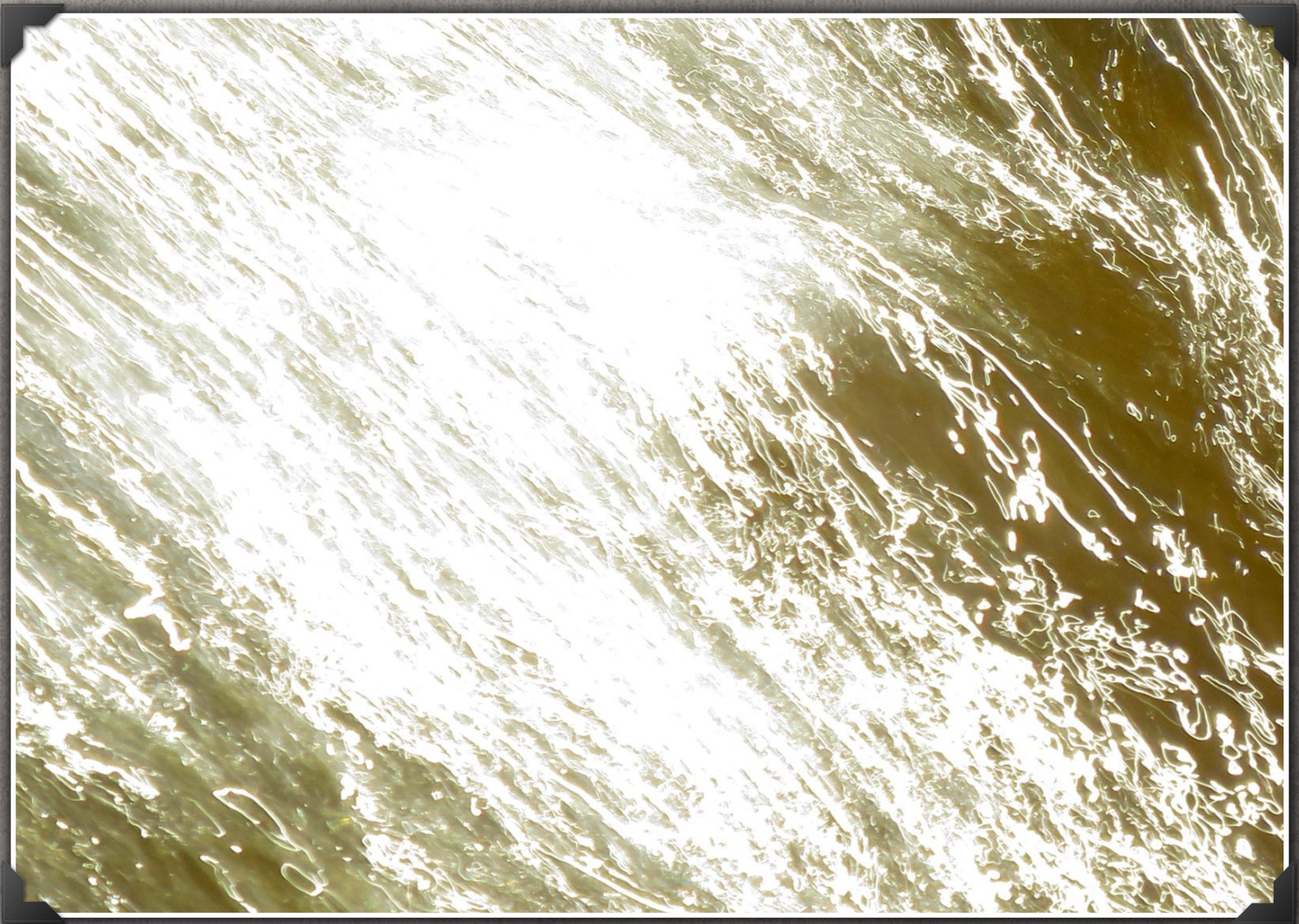

Highlights are often caused by sunlight reflecting on the water's surface, or reflecting off a bubble that is moving around on the water's surface.

























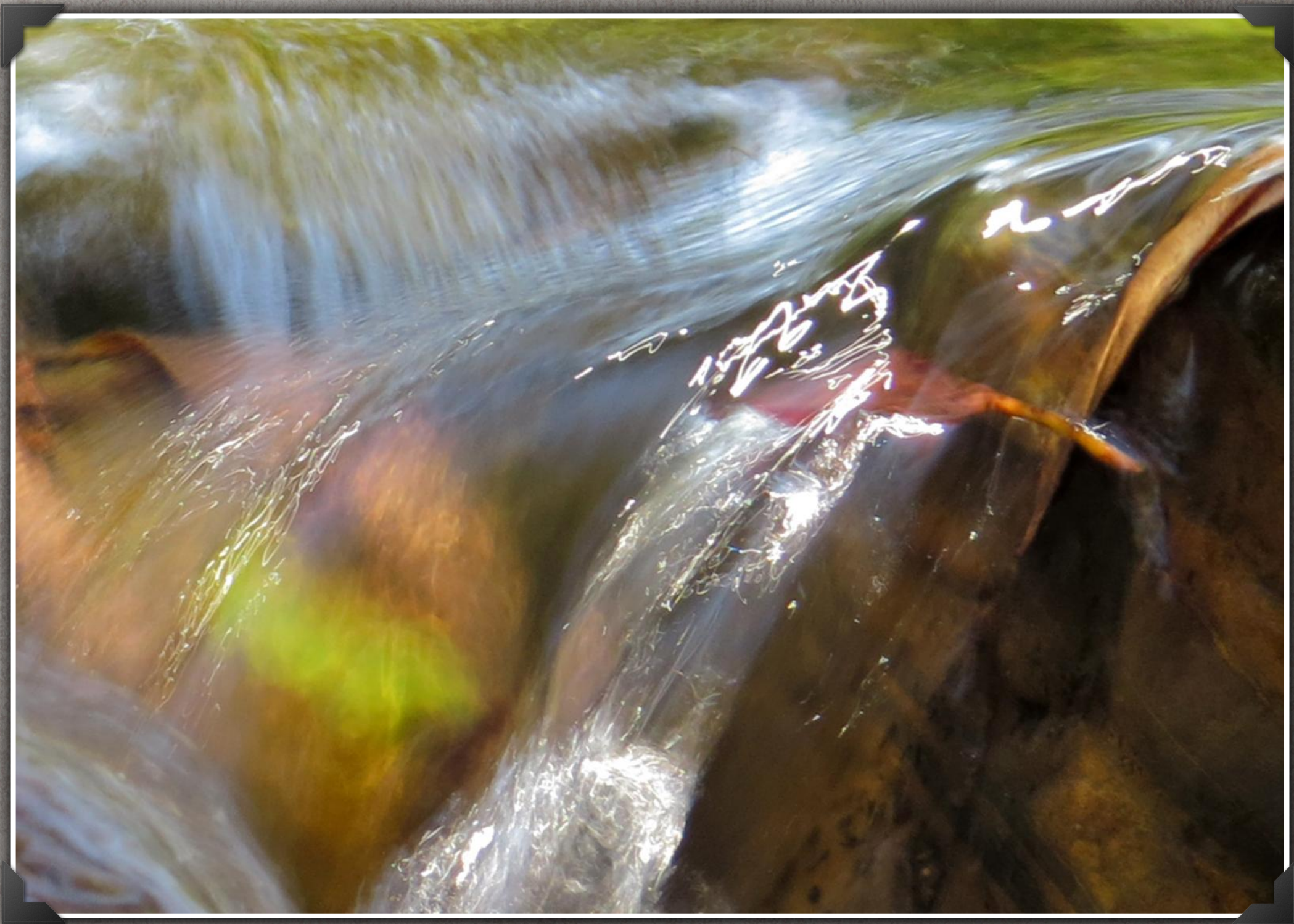

Water Squiggles can be captured by choosing a slower camera shutter speed. This ensures that highlights moving around on the surface of the water have time to be recorded on the camera's digital sensor.

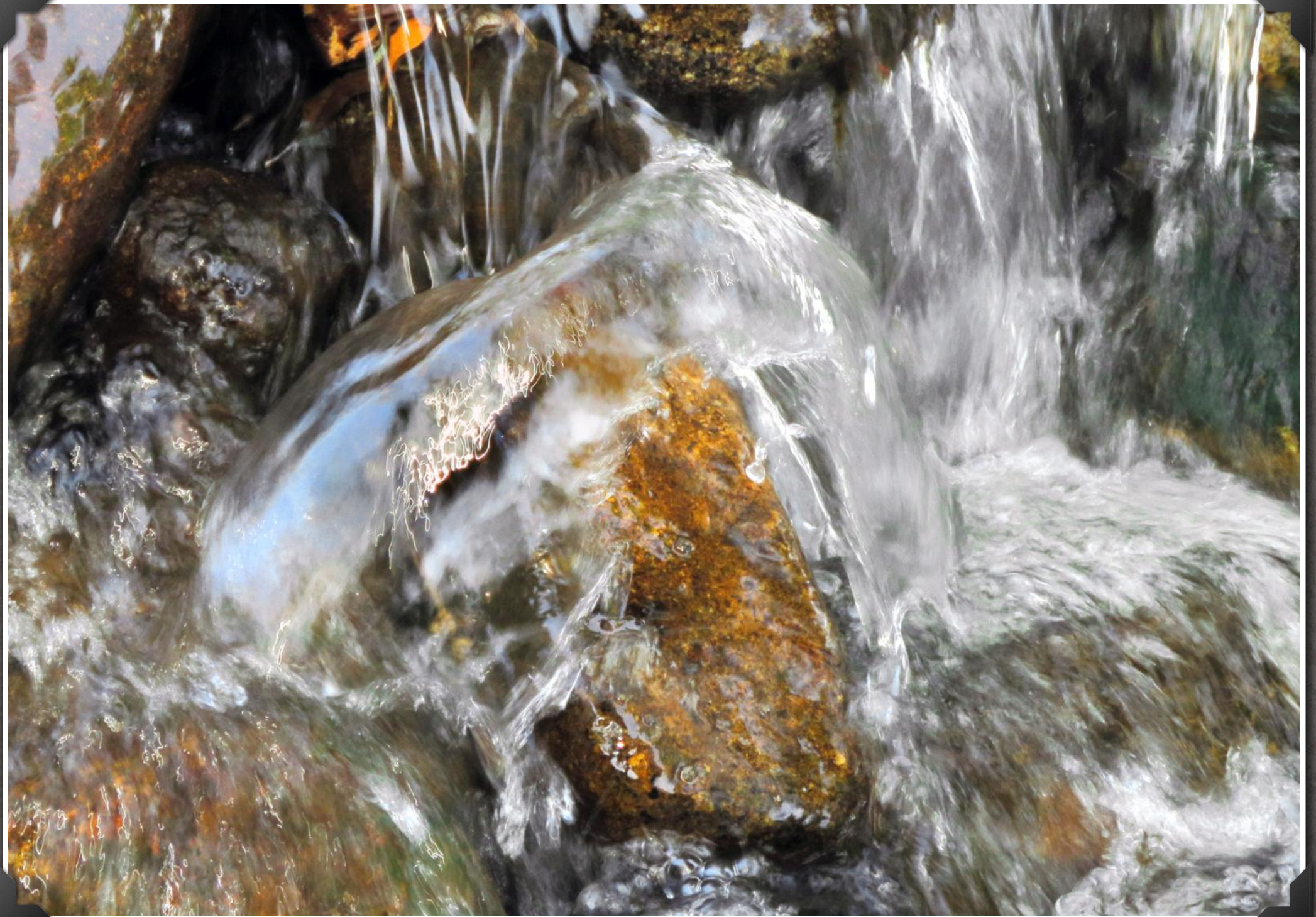












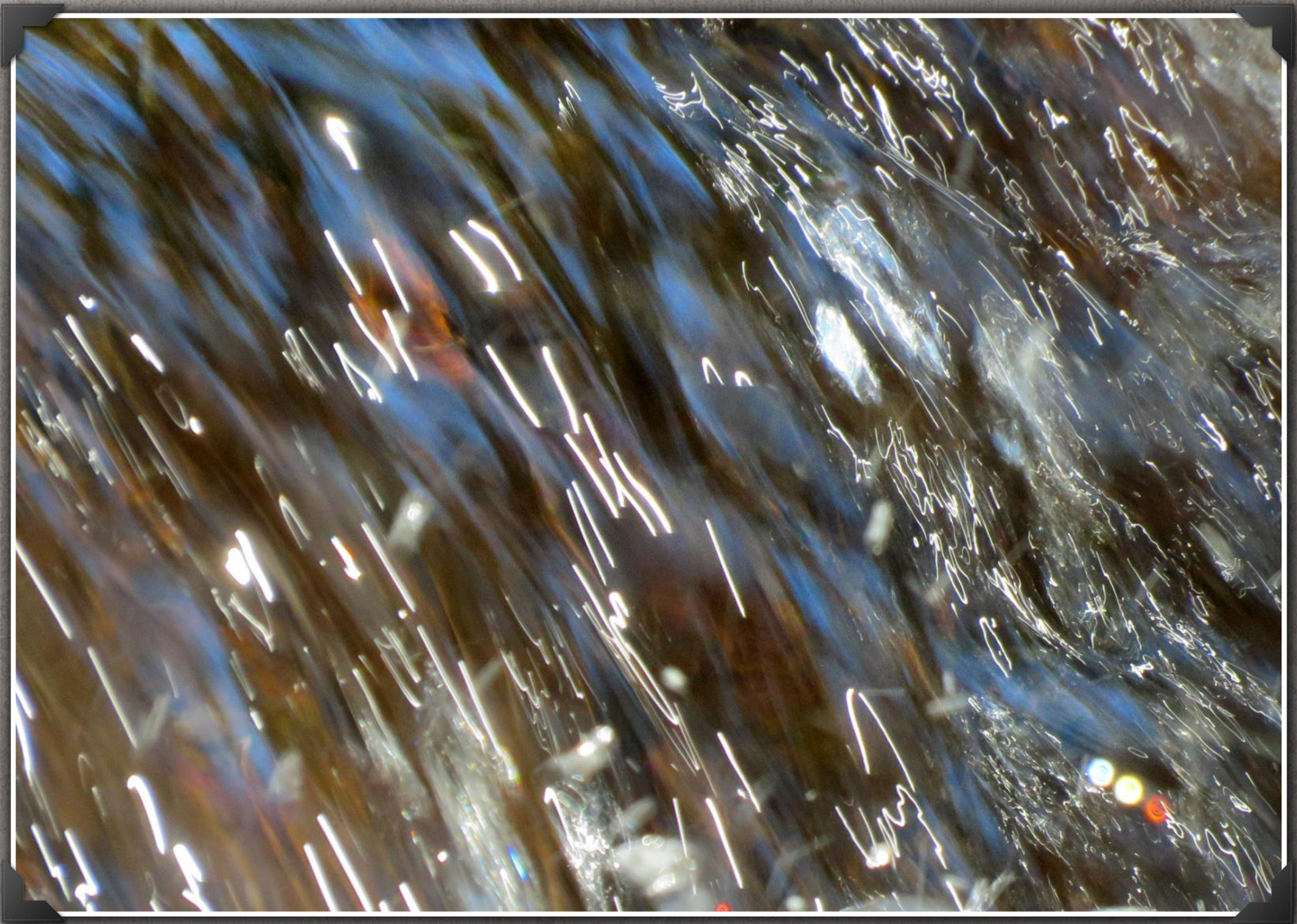




















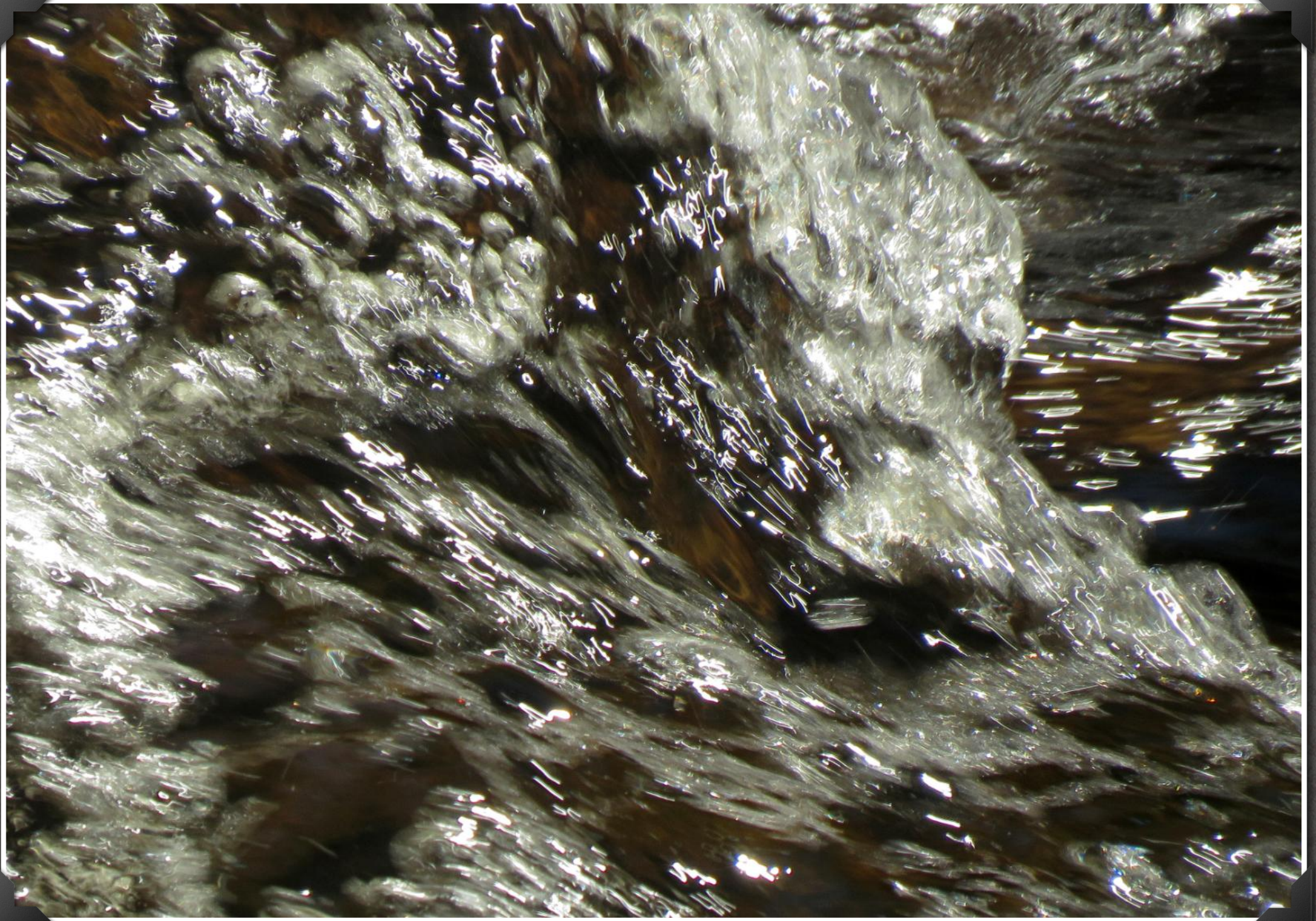












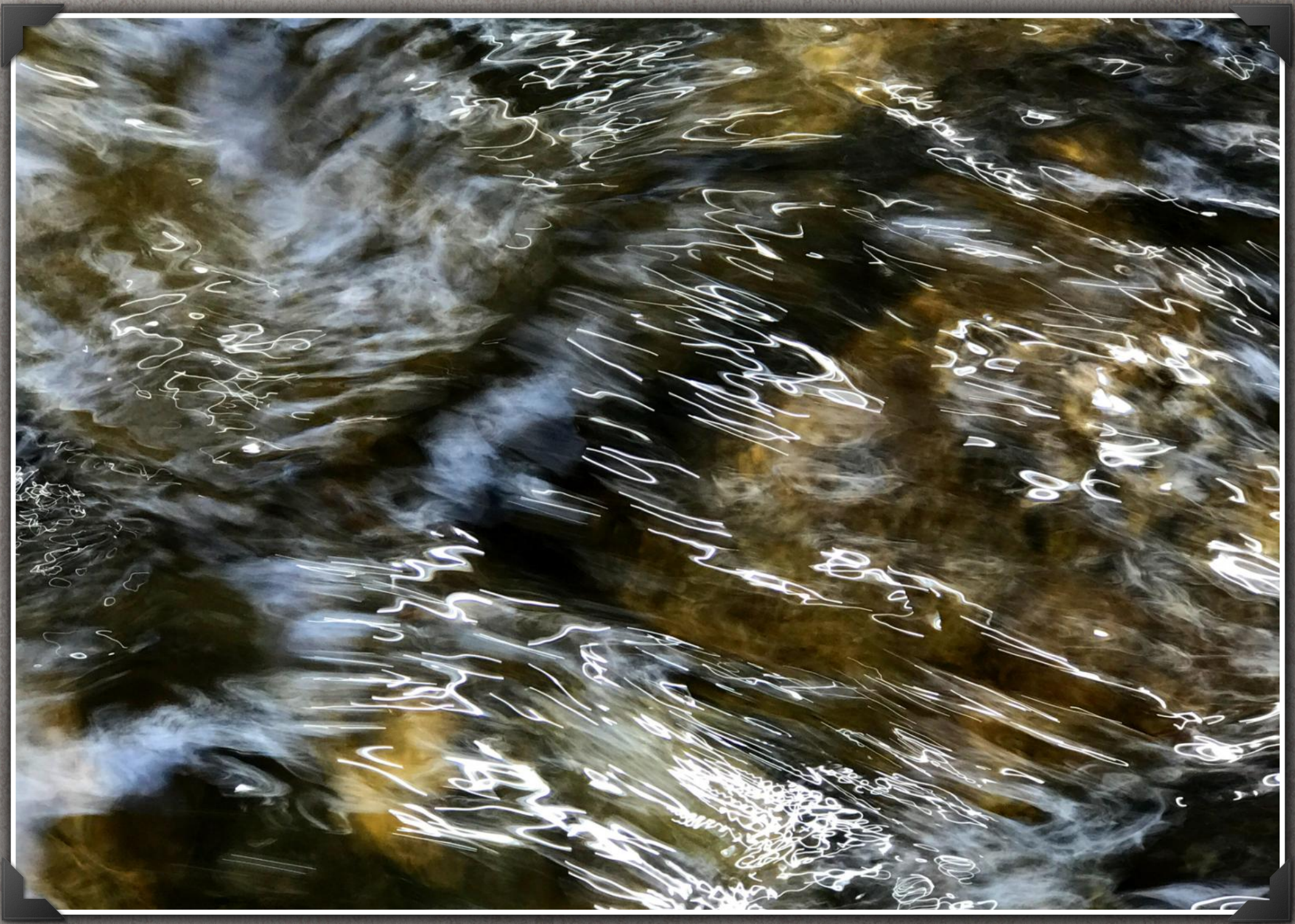








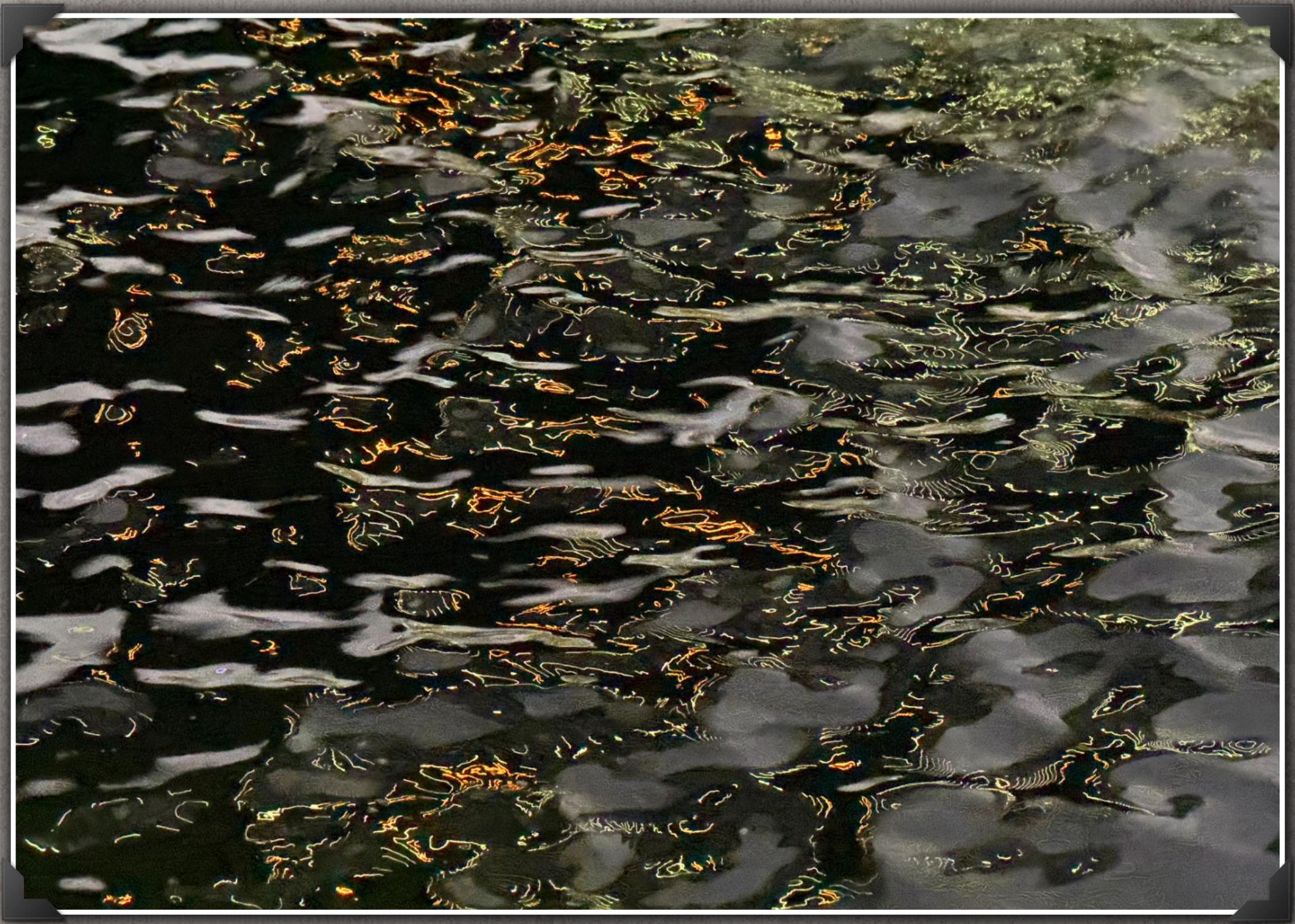














Water squiggles give our brains the opportunity to try and find familiar shapes. This is called pareidolia, the psychological phenomenon where the human mind perceives familiar shapes in random patterns.
