Name: Jacks Falls


Location: Caveat

Type: Small Waterfalls & Cascade

Height: 5 metres

Walk: 500 metres from the road

Jacks Falls is a small waterfall over granite boulders. It is located near Caveat and early photos depict it as a small tourism attraction. Below the Falls are Caveat Cascade and Canyon.



Located off just of the Molesworth Dropmore Road near Caveat, Jacks Falls is a small waterfall that affords you the opportunity to get up very close to it.

The Falls is hard to find due to it being unsigned, and you will have to walk along the side of a valley to access it, though this only takes five minutes and it is well worth the trip. The Falls is best viewed after a soaking rain, though it does flow all year.

August 2013 Artworkz commenced work on this Factsheet.





Bryan's Falls (Jacks Falls) circa 1920
















It is a little hard to get to the bottom of the Caveat Cascades, though the hardship is repaid with beauty. We recommend good bush footwear.






THESE THREE PANORAMAS WERE TAKEN WITH A PHONE.








