INTRODUCTION

The Christmas Tree Festival was the name given to a new and fresh Festival for Alexandra that grew from a vision into a reality through hard work and determination from a number of locals.



The Alexandra Community Christmas Tree Festival was the brainchild of Father Geoff Poliness and Peter Pierce in 2012 when it was run in the St John's Anglican Church and known as the 'Festival of Trees'. It was again run in the Church in 2013 as the Festival of Trees before being handed on to some locals in 2014 who had the dream of keeping teh festival going and building upon its success by creating a long-term event for Alexandra. The resulting festival held in 2014 and 2015 was called the 'Christmas Tree Festival' and was run in the Church Hall. In 2016 it was shifted to the Alexandra Shire Hall.

December 2012	A concept for a Christmas Tree Festival at Alexandra was developed by Father Geoff Poliness and Peter.						
December 2012	The first Christmas Tree Festival was held at Alexandra. It was initially called the 'Festival of Trees; and was held in the St John's Anglican Church. To our knowledge, this was the first Christmas Tree Festival ever held in Alexandra.						
December 2013	The second Festival of Trees was held in the St John's Anglican Church.						
December 2014	The event was handed over to locals upon the retirement of Father Geoff Poliness. The inaugural Alexandra 'Christmas Tree Festival' was held in the St John's Anglican Church Hall.						
December 2014	The third Alexandra Christmas Tree Festival was held in the St John's Anglican Church Hall.						
December 2015	The fourth Alexandra Christmas Tree Festival was held in the St John's Anglican Church Hall. This was the first event with stalls outside the hall.						
December 2016	The fifth Christmas Tree Festival attracted Grant Money and was held at the Alexandra Shire Hall. If attracted more visitors than previously and was also covered by a Television Network which aired it numerous times.						
December 2017	The sixth Christmas Tree Festival was held at the Alexandra Shire Hall. If attracted over 50 new trees and more visitors than the previous year. The committee was also successful in securing the Town Hall for the following three years.						
December 2018	The seventh Christmas Tree Festival was held at the Alexandra Shire Hall. It attracted even more trees and introduced upside- down trees which were hung from the roof.

December 2020 The ninth Christmas Tree Festival was held at the Alexandra Shire Hall. It was held during a period of opening as Victoria held its own against Covid.

December 2021 The tenth Christmas Tree Festival was held at the Alexandra Shire Hall. It was held just after Victoria opened up again from Covid, but just as the new Omicron variant was taking hold in Australia. At the time of the opening, there were ten Covid cases in Alexandra.
