



Foggs Lookout (wrongly signposted and often called Mount Pinniger Lookout) is located 1.8 km to the north west of Mount Pinniger summit and overlooks the Lake Eildon National Park and the township of Eildon. The turnoff to Foggs Lookout is between Eildon and Jerusalem Creek on the Jerusalem Creek Road. Foggs Lookout is 503 m above sea level, 6 km from Eildon and is 33 km from Alexandra.

Once at the lookout, you will be rewarded with a great view of valleys and Lake Eildon below. The upper viewing area offers the best view as well as a table, seating area and a circular direction's plaque set on a stone cairn.

In 2004 four people lost their lives when their light plane clipped the high voltage power lines that stretch from Mount Pinniger to Mount Enterprise on the eastern side of the lake and crashed into the lake. The cables are rated at 220,000 volts each and represent the longest single span in the Southern Hemisphere.

Caution is required when walking from the carpark to the upper viewing area which is in a poor state of disrepair. Take your time and make sure you wear appropriate footwear as there are no handrails on the main path and it is badly eroded.

There is currently no disabled access to the top of the lookout area and the closest public toilet facilities are in Eildon or at the Jerusalem Creek Boat Ramp. There are no longer BBQ facilities available. A picnic table and two chairs are provided at the upper viewing area.

As of 2015 the main sign at the lookout has a misspelt version of the wrong name (Mt Pinniger Lookout) and the elevation is incorrectly listed as 543 m when it is 503 m.

Always be aware of wildlife when driving to and from the lookout and ensure you wear appropriate clothing to protect yourself from ants, snakes and spiders.

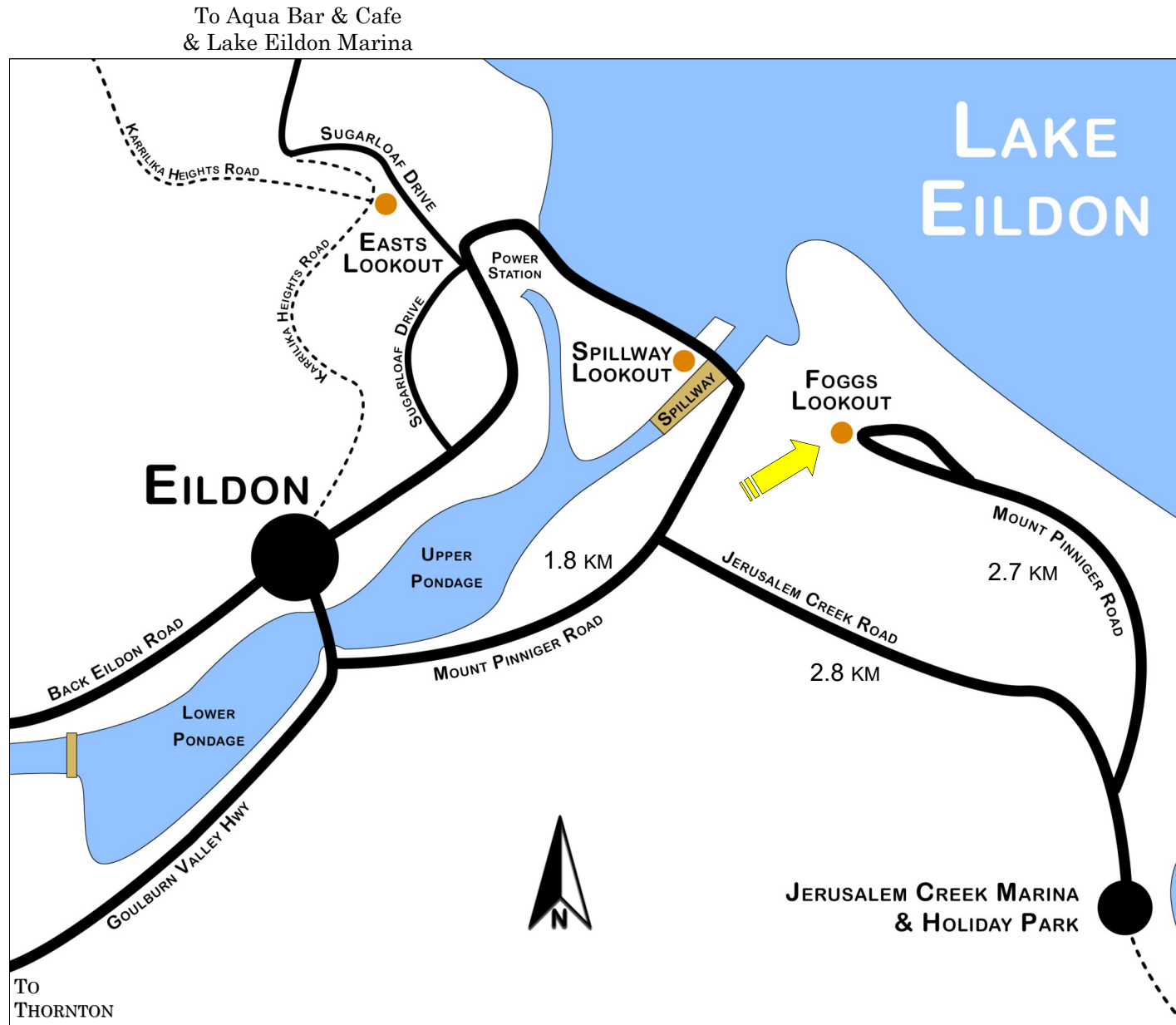

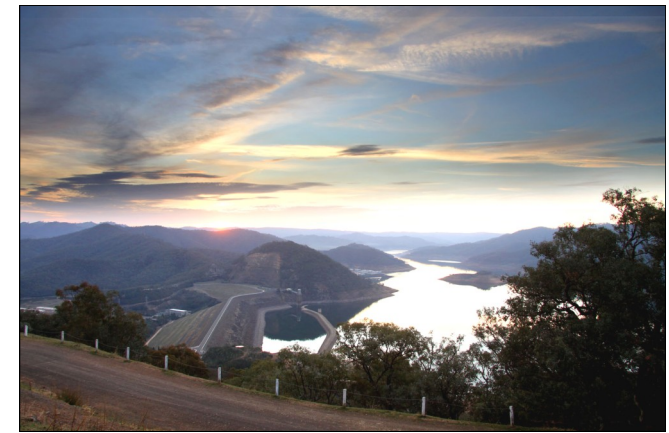

DIRECTIONS

1. Travel to Eildon.
2. From Eildon travel across the Pondage Bridge near the Roundabout and the Golden Trout Hotel Motel.
3. Turn left onto Mount Pinniger Road and travel for 1.8 km.
4. Turn right at the Jerusalem Creek Road and travel 2.8 km to the Mount Pinniger Lookout turnoff on the left.
5. Turn left and travel 2.7 km to Foggs Lookout. Part of this road is gravel and care should be taken.
6. Park in the carpark and walk to the top of the viewing area.

Caution is required when walking from the carpark to the upper viewing area as the walkway is in a poor state of disrepair.
